


CITY LIGHTS

City lights data are a mosaic of Defense Meteorological Satellite Program (DMSP) Operational Linescan System (OLS) images. Images were collected between October 1994 and March 1995. The spatial resolution of these images is 1km (resampled by DMSP from 2.8km). These images are collected at night and include visible light emissions from cities, towns, and industrial sites.
